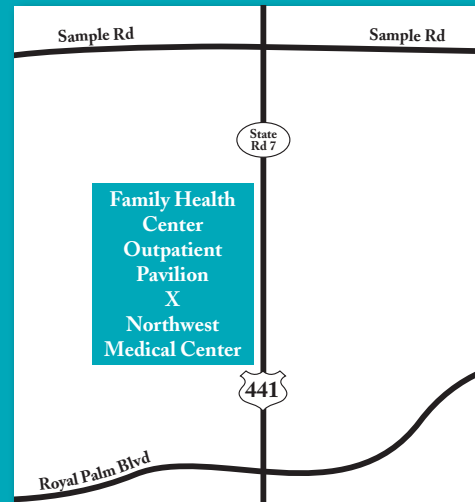


## Practice Overview

### David Porudominsky MD, FACS

Dr. David Porudominsky is a General Surgeon and one of a few fellowship trained surgical oncologists in the area. He has been in private practice in this location since 1985. His practice includes thyroid, parathyroid

surgery, abdominal surgery with minimally invasive laparoscopic techniques including gallbladder, stomach, small and large bowel with special interest in cancer surgery including skin malignancies such as melanoma and soft tissue tumors. He graduated from Cayetano Heredia Medical School in Peru in 1977 and completed a surgical residency at the State University of New York at Stony Brook program in 1982, followed by a fellowship in surgical oncology at the City of Hope National Medical Center. He completed his Board Certification in 1985.

He has been the Chief of Surgery at Northwest Medical Center for many years. He has been a member of the Board of Trustees at Northwest Medical Center and currently holds the position of Vice Chief of Staff. Dr. Porudominsky does in and outpatient surgeries at Northwest Medical Center, Coral Springs Medical Center, Park Creek Medical Center and University Hospital.



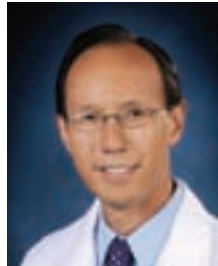
### Eric Kleinstein MD, FACS

Dr. Eric Kleinstein has been practicing in South Florida since 2001. He moved his practice to Margate in September 2003. As a Board Certified General Surgeon, his expertise and special interests

are in Breast Surgery, Laparoscopic Surgery, Thyroid Surgery, Complex Hernia Repairs and Wound Care. Dr. Kleinstein was the first surgeon at Northwest Medical Center to perform a "SILS" Laparoscopic Cholecystectomy (removing a patient's Gall Bladder through only ONE incision.)

Dr. Kleinstein is the Vice Chair of the Department of Surgery at Northwest Medical Center, and sits on many various committees. He is also on the staff at Coral Springs Medical Center, University Hospital, The Wound Care Center at University Hospital and Park Creek Surgical Center.

Dr. Kleinstein attended New York University as an undergraduate. He graduated from UMDNJ - New Jersey Medical School in 1994. He began his residency at Maimonides Medical Center in Brooklyn, NY. After completing a year in research during his residency, he returned to New Jersey Medical School to complete his training. His research has been published in various journals and presented at multiple meetings.



### Pachavit Kasemsap, MD, FACS

Dr. Pachavit Kasemsap is a board certified surgeon in South Florida. He stays current with the latest surgical procedures, including both traditional and laparoscopic (minimally invasive) surgery.

Dr. Kasemsap is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons. He graduated from Washington University School of Medicine, St. Louis, MO and he completed his general surgery residency at University of Illinois, Chicago. After residency, he entered active duty in the US Air Force. He served his country proudly for a total of nine years and reached the rank of Lieutenant Colonel prior to his honorable discharge. While in the military, he established a Bariatric Surgery (weight loss operations) program that was recognized as a Center of Excellence by Air Force Headquarter. In addition Dr. Kasemsap also served as a Flight Surgeon for the 561<sup>st</sup> Fighter Squadron. He specializes in laparoscopic surgery, hiatal hernia repairs, oncologic (cancer) surgery, minimally invasive hernia repairs, and the Lap-Band surgery. He has privileges at Northwest Medical Center, University Hospital and Medical Center, Park Creek Surgery Center, and Coral Springs Medical Center. Dr. Kasemsap has a passion for continuous lifelong learning and is currently enrolled in the University of Miami's MBA program for Health Sector Management.

**General Surgery** includes a wide range of procedures usually performed in the hospital. Many procedures can be performed without the need for an overnight stay in the hospital. Some of the more common procedures are:

#### Appendectomies

**Breast Biopsies** for breast disease. We have the ability to perform minimally invasive breast biopsies in the office.

**Breast Surgery** for cancer including breast conserving lumpectomies and mastectomies.

**Colon Surgery** for cancer, infection and diverticulitis.

**Gallbladder Surgery** for gallbladder disease (Cholecystectomy).

**Hernia Repairs** - Inguinal, ventral, incisional, diaphragmatic, umbilical, complex hernia repairs, component separation technique.

**LAP Band Surgery** minimally invasive FDA approved procedure for weight loss.

**Laparoscopic Nissen Fundoplication and Hiatal Hernia Repair** performed for gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD).

**We do Laparoscopic Minimally Invasive Surgery** for surgery of the gallbladder, appendix, hernia and the colon.

**Sentinel Node Biopsy** for breast cancer and melanoma.

**Thyroid and Parathyroid Surgery** for benign and malignant diseases.
